Dr. Jones is a wheat breeder, professor, and Director of the [WSU Bread Lab](#). At The Bread Lab, Jones tackles problems with our food system from all angles -- production, nutrition, processing, and distribution. Jones researches strains of wheat and other grains best suited for the Pacific Northwest, helps increase yields for farmers, and discovers strains and production practices that allow for flavor and nutritional content not seen in conventional grains. Finally, by reintroducing regional grain farming, mills and other processors can return to the area.
